Objective: Describe the position of the INCERT marking on the product			
<p>Clarifying explanation:</p> <p>The rule INCERT 004 at annex 1 states the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The location of the certification or approval mark will be determined by the certificate (or approval) holder, taking into consideration that after the installation of the equipment, the mark must remain visible without dismantling the equipment (unless the equipment is built-in or is a product for mobile objects). <p>Clarification:</p> <p>Regardless of the type of product, the INCERT marking needs to be positioned:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - on the external enclosure in a way that shall be visible after the installation of the product itself (not allowed on the back side) or - on the internal part of the enclosure, taking into consideration that shall be visible only by opening the enclosure without removing internal components and/or boards.
